• Fabric

Quilting weight cotton (1/16) Yard for Outer layer (1/16) Yard for Lining

Interfacing

(1/16) Yard of fusible fleece

Others

22cm (8¾") Zipper seam allowance included

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SYMBOLS IN THIS PATTERN

Fold Lines

The black dashed line indicates the fold lines. Draw the pattern as is and flip the pattern. Align the center which is the dashed line draw the other half again. Or fold the fabric and place your pattern piece on the folded edge of the fabric.

Notches



Blue star shape are called notches and indicate you need to mark these points to enable you to match up the pattern when sewing. Match the blue lines together at the stars and sellotape together to form the whole of panel. Do this before placing on the fold and cutting the fabrics.

Finish Lines

The gray dash-single dotted line indicates the finishing line excluding the seam allowance. Also, it is the cutting line for the interfacing that without the seam allowance.

Cutting Lines

The black solid line is the cutting line that includes the seam allowance.

• Grain Lines



These double-ended arrows tell you to place the pattern piece parallel to the selvage and along the fabric grainline.

*When printing, make sure you select "no page scaling".

*0.7cm(1/4") Seam allowance included

 $5 \text{cm} \times 5 \text{cm} (2" \times 2")$
